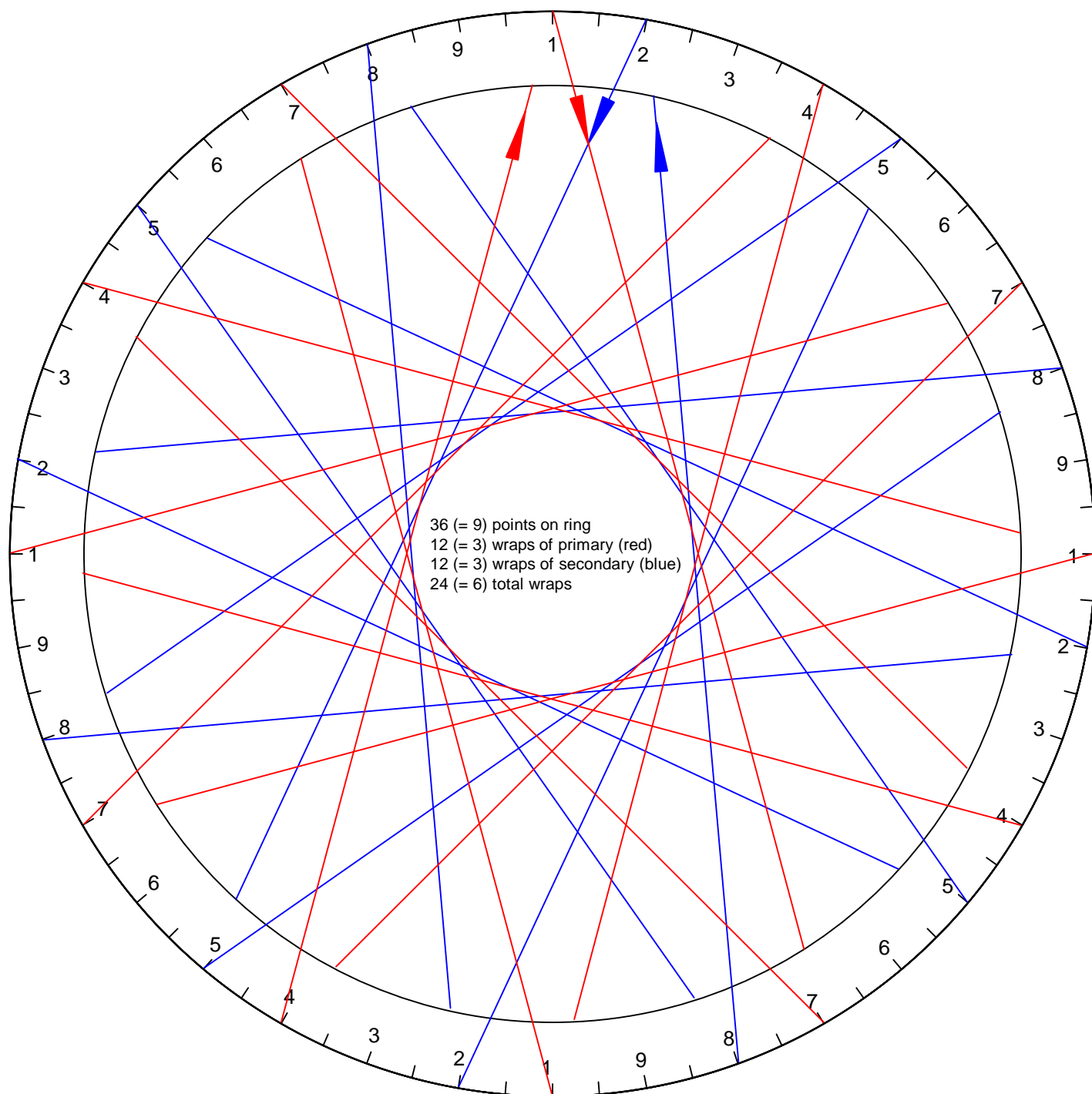


Raising a number to powers...  $x^1, x^2, x^3, x^4, x^5, x^6, x^7, x^8, x^9, \dots$

Red wrap pattern ( $x=7$ ) => 1 7 4 (= 3)

Blue wrap pattern ( $x=7$ ) => 1 7 4 (= 3) when shifted by 1 => 2 8 5 (= 6)

Empty wrap pattern = 3 9 6 or 3 6 9 (= 9)

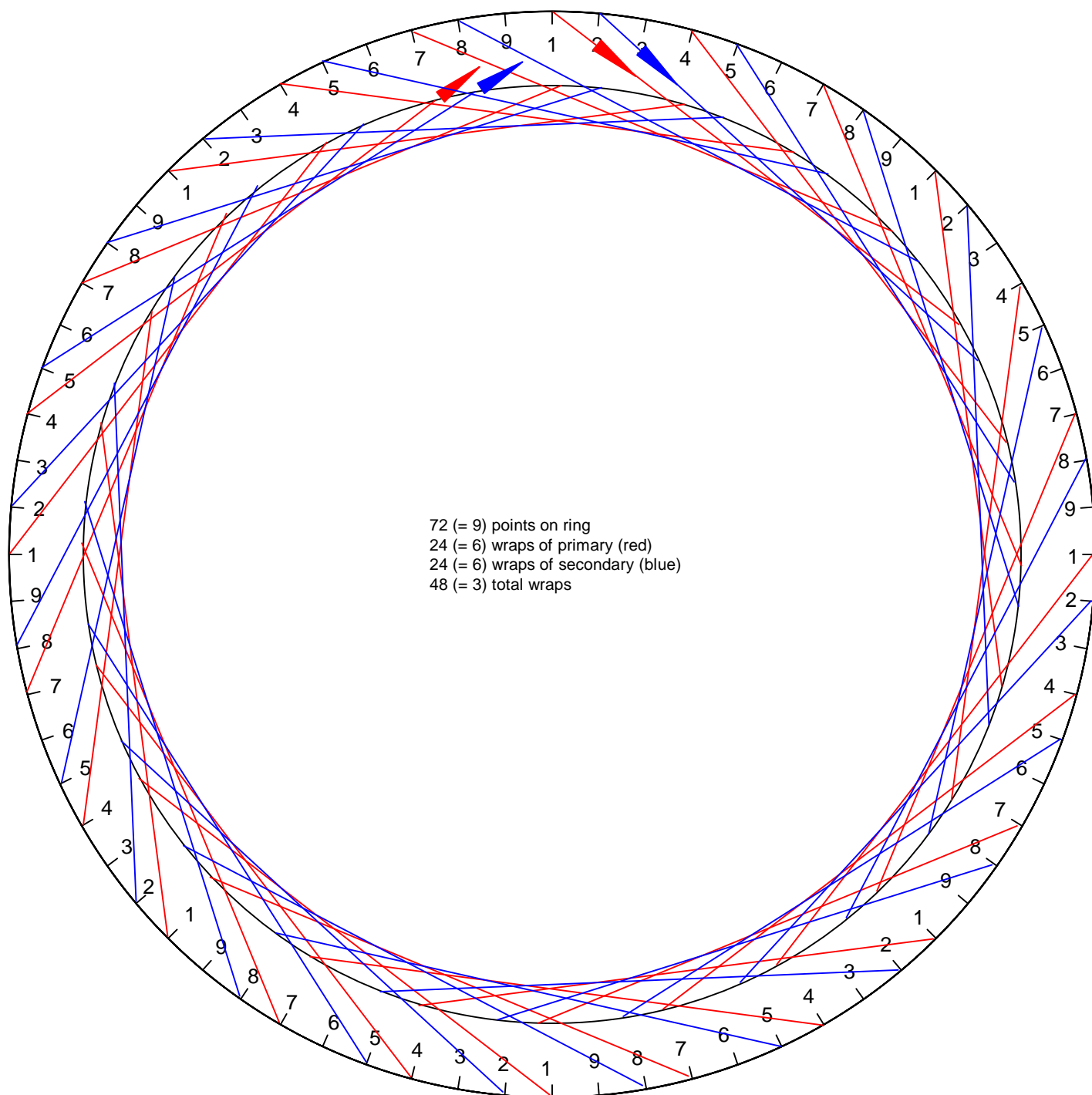


Raising a number to powers...  $x^1, x^2, x^3, x^4, x^5, x^6, x^7, x^8, x^9, \dots$

Red wrap pattern ( $x=7$ )  $\Rightarrow$  1 7 4 (= 3)

Blue wrap pattern ( $x=4$ )  $\Rightarrow$  1 4 7 (= 3) when shifted by 1  $\Rightarrow$  2 5 8 (= 6)

Empty wrap pattern = 3 9 6 or 3 6 9 (= 9)

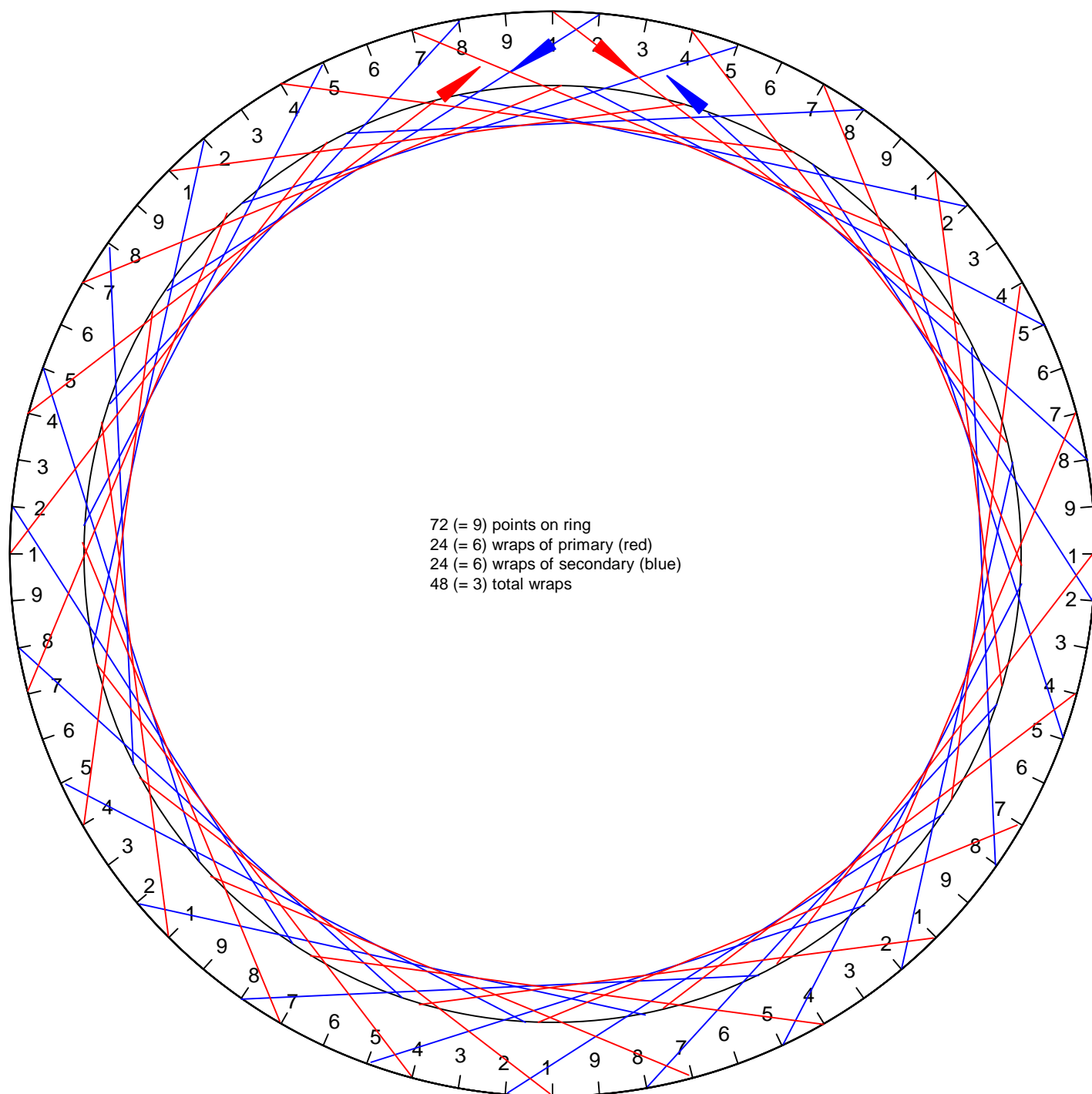


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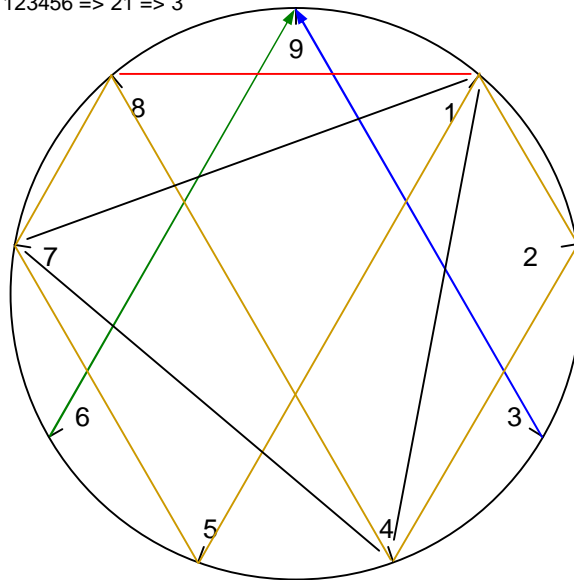
Empty wrap pattern = 3 9 6 or 3 6 9 (= 9)

### Basic Numerology rules

- 1) Take a number and add all its individual digits together.
- 2) If you have more than one digit in the resulting number repeat step 1.

Examples:

$8 \Rightarrow 8$   
 $16 \Rightarrow 7$   
 $49 \Rightarrow 13 \Rightarrow 4$   
 $123456 \Rightarrow 21 \Rightarrow 3$

x	values	Resulting value	My interpretation
2	2, 4, 8, 16, 32, 64, 128, ...	2, 4, 8, 7, 5, 1, 2, ...	clockwise infinity
3	3, 9, 27, 81, 243, 729, ...	3, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, ...	migrates to perfect / stable
4	4, 16, 64, 256, 1024, ...	4, 7, 1, 4, 7, 1, 4, ...	clockwise triangle
5	5, 25, 125, 625, 3125, 15625, 78125, ...	5, 7, 8, 4, 2, 1, 5, ...	counter clockwise infinity
6	6, 36, 216, 1296, 7776, ...	6, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, ...	migrates to perfect / stable
7	7, 49, 343, 2401, 16807, ...	7, 4, 1, 7, 4, 1, 7, ...	counter clockwise triangle
8	8, 64, 512, 4096, 32768, ...	8, 1, 8, 1, 8, 1, 8, ...	oscillation (shield of 9?)
9	9, 81, 729, 6561, 59049, ...	9, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, ...	perfect / stable

### Just a Thought

Pulsing the coil at 7.83Hz is said to have good effects.

$783 \Rightarrow 9$  a perfect / stable number.
